




## 10 Day Luxury Mobile Sample Itinerary Kenya

Day 1	<p>Met by <b>Derek Dames Safaris</b> after an evening arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, Nairobi. Day 2	<p>After a leisurely breakfast with the giraffe, transfer to Wilson Airport for our 10:30 Private Charter to Amboseli National Park. Met at the airstrip and drive to camp for lunch. Camp is set facing Africa's tallest Mountain, Kilimanjaro. Afternoon walk or game drive to the Amboseli lake-bed. Day 3	<p>Situated next to, and originally part of Amboseli National Park, our 28,000-acre Kitirua Concession is the core area of some of the oldest &amp; biggest bull elephants in Africa. Bird life is also abundant in the acacia woodland and swamps. Walking and night drives. All meals from camp.</p>	 <p><b>AMBOSELI PRIVATE CAMP</b></p>

Day 4	<p>Besides the Tuskers, viewing here is also for warthogs, Maasai giraffe, Common zebra, Grant's gazelle, Thomson's gazelle, wildebeest, Vervet monkeys, baboon, buffalo, impala, fringe-eared oryx, jackal and hyena. Morning and afternoon game drives.</p> <p>Time can also be spent with the Maasai here understanding how this pastoral culture has existed for eons in the Amboseli eco-system. A visit to a Maasai Boma to see how this fascinating culture survives in the 21st century is highly recommended. All meals from camp.</p>	  <p><b>AMBOSELI PRIVATE CAMP</b></p>
Day 5	<p>A morning flight gets us to Borana Lodge, situated on Borana Game Ranch, where we will spend two nights. This allows the mobile camp time to pack up and move from Amboseli to the Masai Mara.</p> <p>Borana is a Private Ranch and we are free to explore it as we wish. Activities include walking, cycling, fishing, horseback riding and night game drives.</p> <p>You may of course prefer just to relax and enjoy the wonderful view from the pool.</p>	  <p><b>BORANA LODGE</b>  <a href="http://www.borana.co.ke">http://www.borana.co.ke</a></p>

Day 6	<p>A morning game drive through the Ngare Sergoi Rhino Sanctuary, on the neighboring Lewa Downs ranch, will give us some of the best game viewing opportunities for both black and white rhino.</p> <p>After a picnic breakfast we will return to the lodge for lunch.</p> <p>Evening game drive or walk or horseback riding. Also seen here are lion, cheetah and occasionally hunting dogs. The birdlife is also prolific through the numerous vegetation zones. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.</p>	  <p><b>BORANA LODGE</b></p>
Day 7	<p>After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip and Private Air Charter at 10:00 to the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Met at the airstrip and game drive to Camp for lunch.</p> <p>Afternoon and evening game drive, returning to cocktails around the campfire, supper and overnight in camp. Day 8	<p>Game viewing here is also for elephant, Masai giraffe, Thomson's gazelle, hippo, baboon, Black-faced Vervet monkeys, hartebeest, lion, hyena, jackal and topi. On some of these days we may take a picnic breakfast or lunch to the Mara River to look for hippos and crocodiles in the river. All meals from camp.</p>	

Day 9	<p>Eland, water buck, impala, Grant's gazelle, buffalo, hartebeest. There are also over 480 species of bird to be found in the rolling hills and riverine forests of the Mara. Morning and afternoon game drives all meals from camp</p>	
Day 10	<p>After breakfast in camp, drive to the airstrip and a 45-minute flight at 10:00 to Nairobi &amp; transfer to HEMMINGWAYS for lunch &amp; day rooms. Afternoon relaxing or repacking. Evening transfer to the Dames Residence for Tea &amp; Cocktails and transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your 19:35 &amp; 22:45 flights to Europe.</p>	 <p><b>FLIGHT OUT</b></p>
